

## YR 11 Art Project pre 6<sup>th</sup> Form Study

Hello team! I hope you are all doing well over this lockdown period. It's great to have so many of you wanting to continue with your art studies at KS5. In preparation for this, I have set the work below to stop you from getting rusty over the next few weeks. If you have a sketchbook to use, great, but working on loose paper is fine, just keep it logical.

Art and Photography have been set the same project but you will study different artists and produce different pieces.

I would like you to work on a Landscape mini-project. You may set it out as you see fit, and choose your own artists to study. Draw/ photograph from life where you can and use a range of materials you have at home. Follow the suggested structure to complete the project which should last 4 weeks (roughly 10-12 sides).

- Title page: Landscape
- Brainstorm types of landscape/ artists etc. Choose a theme within this to study and explain your choice
- Moodboard to show visuals of your chosen area
- 1<sup>st</sup> artist (you know the formula): info, examples of their work, analyse one in full, copy a small section, do your own in response
- 2<sup>nd</sup> Artist – repeat the above
- Final piece ideas. Use your research and own photos/ sketches to develop a final Landscape outcome.
- Final piece – if you have separate board/ canvas, or 3D materials – great, otherwise complete it in your book.

Have fun with this – choose a different style to work – come out of your comfort zone. Be creative, take risks – go for it! Below are some artists you could have a look at if you are stuck for inspiration – remember, you can choose your own.
