

YR 11 Photography Project pre 6th Form Study

Hello team! I hope you are all doing well over this lockdown period. It's great to have so many of you wanting to continue with your photography studies at KS5. In preparation for this, I have set the work below to stop you from getting rusty over the next few weeks. If you have a sketchbook to use, great, but if you would rather work digitally within PowerPoint, then that is also a great option.

Art and Photography have been set the same project but will study different artists and produce different pieces.

I would like you to work on a Landscape mini-project. You may set it out as you see fit, and choose your own artists to study. (Choose a different theme/ artists if you also study art). Think about good quality images, and a range of editing techniques inspired by the artists you choose. Follow the suggested structure to complete the project which should last 4 weeks (roughly 14-16 sides).

- Title page: Landscape
- Brainstorm types of landscape/ artists etc. Choose a theme within this to study and explain your choice
- Moodboard to show visuals of your chosen area
- 1st artist (you know the formula): info, examples of their work, analyse one in full, plan your own shoot in response. Edit.
- 2nd Artist – repeat the above
- Final piece ideas. Use your research/ sketches/ shoots to develop a final Landscape outcome.
- Final piece – if you can print it– great, otherwise complete digitally.

Have fun with this – choose a different style of work – come out of your comfort zone. Be creative, take risks – go for it! Below are some artists you could have a look at if you are stuck for inspiration – remember, you can choose your own.
