
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All GCSE courses are graded with a scale from 9 to 1, with 9 being the highest grade.

Cambridge National qualifications are graded as a pass, merit or distinction at either level 1 or level 2. The grades are displayed in the following format, running from lowest to highest; P1, M1, D1, P2, M2, D2, D2*. This means that D2* is the highest grade it is possible to achieve.

NCFE Technical awards have the following levels, D, C, B, A, A*. For this qualification A* is the highest level that is attainable



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
