We hope you and your families are well.

Our Ralph Allen students have continued to demonstrate resilience and positivity despite the many challenges of the last 16 months. We are very proud of our young people.

Although we are unable to run our normal offer of trips and residentials, due to covid restrictions, we are organising some free, fun activities to end the year positively in the week beginning 12 July 2021.

All year groups will be participating in a variety of events and workshops, alongside their normal timetable and we will end the week, on Friday 16 July, with the whole school Sponsored Walk along our famous Bath Skyline to raise money for our urban outdoor gym equipment. You will receive a separate letter from Ms Hetenyi outlining the programme for the Sponsored Walk day and the permission slips required.

Year 8 'I Can and I Am' Workshop:

During the week we are delighted to be welcoming the **'I Can and I Am' team** into Ralph Allen School in their double decker bus and with their golden retriever Darcy. Throughout the week all our year 8 students will listen to a presentation by the charity founder James Shone and then each student will be invited to spend one hour on board the I Can & I Am bus.

On board the bus, students will take part in a pizza making session on the ground floor which has been converted in to a state of the art kitchen by the bus sponsors, Howdens. Cooking is a proven therapeutic activity that provides an informal distraction, but also offers natural breaks for a deeper conversation to evolve. Students will then take part in a half hour workshop on the top deck of the bus where they'll spend time with James or another of the team members, discussing further many of the messages from James's talk.

The aim is that they will leave the session with a better understanding of their own qualities and strengths, plus one or two tools that may help them to manage their own emotions and to deal with any setbacks that arise for them, or others close to them in the future.

This will be a unique experience in a positive environment where students can focus solely on themselves and their own wellbeing.
