- ▶ 1 essay question, choose 1 of the 2. Always covers 2 of the 4 topics
- ▶ Essay question based on 1918-51
- ▶ 25% of you're A Level

What will I study on this course?

- ▶ Philip's Political Authority - Governance, Administration and Court Factions
- ▶ Religious issues such as the Spanish Inquisition and Church Reform, and the Moriscos and Conversos
- ▶ Foreign Policy, such as the Spanish Armada, the war with the Turks, and the ongoing war with France
- ▶ The Netherlands Revolt, its causes, events and consequences

How am I examined?

- ▶ 1 hour exam
- ▶ 2 types of questions – a 10 mark comparison question and a 20 mark essay question
- ▶ Choice of which questions you answer (set A or set B) – Yay! A ‘set’ contains a 10 marker and a 20 marker
- ▶ 15% of your A Level
